

**OFFENSE:** Larceny from Auto / Receiving & Concealing Stolen Property \$1,000-\$20,000

## General description of circumstances:

On the above date and time the New Baltimore Police, while on routine patrol, observed an interior light of a vehicle illuminated that was parked in the driveway of a home on the 36000 block of St. Clair Drive. The suspect, an 18yr old w/m resident of Chesterfield Township, was discovered alongside of the vehicle and attempted to flee the officer; however, he was later stopped and investigated.

The investigation yielded that the suspect was in possession of stolen property between \$1,000 & \$20,000 along with other various stolen items from vehicles within the City of New Baltimore. The suspect admitted to the entering of multiple vehicles in multiple locations without the owner's permission and the taking of property which did not belong to him.

The suspect was processed at the New Baltimore Police Department and transported to the Macomb County Jail. Officers are seeking criminal charges that include multiple counts of LFA (Larceny from Auto's) and R & C (Receiving and Concealing Stolen Property) \$1,000-\$20,000. An arraignment, of the suspect, will take place at the 42-2 District Court in New Baltimore.
